ST. PETER FOUNDATION MEETING

The St. Peter Foundation has received a funding request on behalf of the Technology and Building committees.

At the time of the new school, (years of 2012 and 2013), the fire alarm code mandated voice enunciation only for schools with a capacity exceeding 300 students. Wisconsin has since adopted the 2015 International Building Fire Code. It revised the requirement for voice enunciation to include schools with a capacity over 99 students. As St. Peter school's current capacity exceeds this threshold, it has become necessary to upgrade the fire alarm system in our current school building to comply with the revised codes.

On Sunday, May 19 at 9:15 am there will be a St. Peter Foundation meeting in the conference room. All Congregation members, 18 and older, in good standing, are eligible to vote. The members will be informed about the request, be able to ask questions and then be asked to act on the funding request.
